Unbundling tariffs: Arcep submits its draft decision to the European Commission setting the terms of price supervision for access to the Orange copper local loop for three years, from 2026 to 2028

Paris, 27 February 2025

After a public consultation on the draft decision on price supervision for access to the Orange copper local loop, subject to cost-based pricing¹, Arcep is submitting the draft decision to the European Commission for comment. This is the final stage before the Authority's adoption of this decision.

The responses to the public consultation, which ran from 5 December 2024 to 17 January 2025, did not lead the Authority to make any substantial changes to the draft decision. In particular, the Authority plans on maintaining the recurring monthly rate of €9.20 from 2026 to 2028.

Depending on the comments received from the European Commission, the Authority could adopt the final decision in April of this year.
