Frequency awards in Saint-Barthélemy: Results of the auction for the paired block of 5 MHz in the 2.1 GHz band

Paris, 16 May 2023

The auction stage for the award of a paired block of 5 MHz in the 2.1 GHz band in Saint-Barthélemy took place yesterday. This auction is part of the procedures for awarding licences to use frequencies in the 700 MHz and 3.4-3.8 GHz bands in Saint-Martin and Saint-Barthélemy and in the 900 MHz and 2.1 GHz bands in Saint-Barthélemy which began on 30 September 2022.

Results of the quantities of frequencies awarded in the 2.1 GHz band in Saint-Barthélemy

The quantities of frequencies awarded through the assignment procedure for a paired block of 5 MHz in the 2.1 GHz band in Saint-Barthélemy, provided the procedure is brought to completion, are as follows:
